

### UGC'S NEW GUIDELINES ON EXAMINATION

As per the revised guidelines, UGC has asked all the colleges and Universities to conduct the final year or semester examination by the end of September. The colleges however have the freedom of choosing the mode of exam - online, offline and/or hybrid.

The new guidelines further suggest holding special exams for students "in case a student of terminal semester or final year is unable to appear in the examination". These special examination may be held whenever the situation becomes conducive. This comes after several Universities had already announced the cancellation of exams.

These guidelines are likely to influence the decisions taken by Aryabhata Knowledge University and Bihar School Examination Board, Patna.

### SUCCESSFUL ONLINE INTERNAL EXAMINATION CONDUCTED BY COLLEGE

Amaltas College of Education successfully conducted the internal examination for the B.Ed. and the D.El.Ed. students. The examination was conducted online amidst the corona virus threat between 22nd July and 27th July 2020. The college used the Google Classroom and Google Forms applications to conduct the examination.

It took tremendous effort from the faculty and technical staff to prepare around 4000+ multiple choice questions for 50 B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. courses. 2400 questions were finally picked for the examination. The entire process was carried out in paperless manner, was transparent, and provided instant results to the students.

The students' response is very encouraging. They have adapted to the new technology and new ways of learning in very quick time, and now feel that the use of technology is the need of the hour, and an alternative to the traditional way of learning and teaching.

### B.ED. EXAMINATION SCHEDULE 2020

Aryabhata Knowledge University has extended the last date of filling the online examination form for both the first and second year B.Ed. students till the 20th of August 2020. The exams, presently scheduled for 12th August has also been postponed. The new dates may be announced in next two weeks.

Bihar School Examination Board has also postponed the D.El.Ed. annual exams for both years scheduled from the 24th of July 2020. The new dates of are expected to be announced very soon.

### NEW ADMISSIONS FOR 2020-22 SESSION

Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Darbhanga has once again postponed the B.Ed. common entrance test which was scheduled for 19th July. Admission to the new academic session 2020-22 is pending across all the colleges of Bihar.

BSEB, Patna has also postponed the D.El.Ed. CET scheduled for 20th July 2020. Admissions to two years D.El.Ed. course is also pending across all the D.El.Ed. colleges in Bihar. The new dates for the common entrance tests may be announced in next few days.
