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International Literacy Day Celebration

Orientation | D.El.Ed. 2021-23 Session

The session aimed at giving an overview about the academic course to be pursued by the students followed by a formal introduction session with teachers and the staff members.

Internship | Observation & Practice Teaching



Teaching internship is a very important component of every student-teacher's training. Students are required to do 4 weeks of observation and 16 weeks of 'practice teaching' in local schools, as part of their curriculum specified by National Council for Teachers Education, a statutory body of the Government of India to monitor standards, procedures and processes in the Indian Education system. Due to the second wave of the pandemic, the internship was delayed and reduced.

The students of D.El.Ed. and B.Ed. first year completed their teaching observation in various schools in the month of October 2021, while the second year D.El.Ed. students did their practice teaching during this period.

Results | B.Ed. and D.El.Ed.

Results of B.Ed. first year (2020-22) was declared by the University in January 2022. 46 out of 48 students passed with first division. Anuragini Kumari topped the list with 81.23%. Lovely Kumari with 78.62% and Nilu Kumari with 77.23% stood second and third respectively.

B.Ed. second-year results of academic session 2019-21 was declared in December 2021. 43 out of 46 students passed with first division. KM Arpita Singh topped with 80.69% followed by Ramita Rawat who scored 78.38%. Rubab Fatma stood third in the batch with overall score of 78.23%.

The results of D.El.Ed. first and second year is expected in the month of February 2022.
