



Start of our 9th Academic Year

On **8-July-2024** we welcomed back our 2nd-year B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. students awaiting our new batch impacted by delayed admissions.

Early Preparations for Pre-School Internship Training

This year's planning for pre-internship training began well in advance, on **22nd July 2024**. Reflecting on the insights and experiences gained over the past years, we revamped our approach to better equip students for their school internships.

Notably, we introduced a new partnership with **Pratham**, integrating their 'Learning at the Right Level' program into our internship curriculum, aiming to enhance our students' impact in real classroom settings.

Pre-internship training officially kicked off on **2nd September**.

B.Ed. University Exam Results

The results of the recent B.Ed. University exams for both the 1st (2023-25) and 2nd Year (2022-24) cohorts have been announced. While the college values holistic learning over any single exam, it's worth noting that our students performed well and met our expectations.

Special BPSC Classes for Government School Aspirants

Our BPSC preparation classes, essential for students aiming for government teaching positions, began on **9th September 2024** and will continue alongside their academic schedule. The program is spread over **16 weeks**.

Classes will pause during the school internship period and resume in February, concluding in May just before internal exams. This initiative, **running parallel to the core academic program**, reflects our ongoing commitment to supporting students beyond the classroom and helping them achieve their career aspirations.

Admissions for the 2024-26 Batch

Admissions for the **9th batch of B.Ed. and 7th batch of D.El.Ed. students**, which should have been completed by June, have once again been delayed. B.Ed. admissions are only now nearing completion, with orientation planned for **17th October**. Meanwhile, D.El.Ed. admissions have just begun, and based on previous years, classes for this batch may not start until November.

These delays have placed considerable pressure on our academic calendar, underscoring the need for more efficient and timely processes to safeguard the quality of education.
