

Learning to Teach at the Level of the Child: TaRL Workshop



October 2024 & January 9-12 2025

In a continuation of our mutually enriching partnership with Pratham, a highly regarded organization, our D.El.Ed. students (2022-24) attended their second workshop with Pratham on their Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) methodology, **a powerful approach to bridging learning gaps in primary education.** This intensive training was strategically planned as a prelude to their 16-week school internship, ensuring that they could apply TaRL techniques in real classroom settings.

A Two-Stage Training Approach - allowing students to first assess learning levels and later implement targeted interventions to enhance learning outcomes.

Stage 1: Pre-Assessment Training (18-Oct-2024)

Following a 1-day training, students visited four local schools and assessed competency levels in literacy and numeracy of 300 children. The results closely mirrored findings from ASER surveys, confirming that a majority of the children were not learning at their expected level.

Stage 2: Intervention Training (9-12 Jan 2025)

In the 2nd phase, our students received 4-days of hands-on training in TaRL methodologies, equipping them with strategies and tools to bring children up to the expected learning level. They then returned to their schools to implement their learned interventions.



Impact & Looking Ahead


Our students are currently applying TaRL techniques in their internship schools. The results of their efforts is expected by mid-Feb 2025, and eagerly awaited.

Our collaboration with Pratham is a significant enhancement of our curriculum. Recognizing the potential impact of this association, we are currently working on a plan to extend this collaboration into a multi-year effort.






Parakram Diwas: Honoring Netaji & the Women Warriors Who Made History

23 January 2025

Few figures in history command as much admiration, intrigue, and debate as **Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose**. A leader who inspired millions, he was a visionary who saw an independent India when it was still a distant dream. His daring escape from British surveillance, his alliances across continents, and his formation of the **Indian National Army (INA)** marked him as a man far ahead of his time. Even his death remains shrouded in mystery - an enigma that continues to spark debate and fascination. But what is beyond question is his legacy. Today, history is increasingly recognizing Netaji as **the man who forced the British to leave India**.

As we reflect on Netaji's enduring impact, we also turn our attention to a remarkable woman Lt. Bharati 'Asha' Sahay Choudhry, now 97 and a veteran of the Rani Jhansi Regiment of the INA, the first all-women military wing of the world. Lt. Bharati was among the young women who took up arms under his leadership. At just 17, she trained as a soldier in Burma, prepared to fight for the freedom of a country she had never even seen. Her journey, defined by courage and conviction, is a living testament to Netaji's belief that women had an equal role to play in India's struggle for independence.

Bringing this extraordinary piece of history closer to home, Lt. Bharati is also the mother-in-law of our college secretary, Ratna Choudhry. Her story, long preserved within her family, has now reached a wider audience through "The War Diary of Asha-san", a recently published translation of her wartime journal by her great-granddaughter-in-law. This invaluable historical account offers a rare, firsthand glimpse into the lived experiences of the women who stood at the forefront of India's struggle for independence.



The stories of **Netaji, Asha-san and the fearless women of the INA**, are not just pages from history - they inform us of the power of conviction and resilience in the unwavering pursuit of freedom.

Academic Update 2024-25

B.Ed. Admissions (2024-26)

We are pleased to announce the successful completion of the admission process for the 2024-26 B.Ed. batch, with **all 50 seats filled**. Following a delayed and chaotic admission schedule presided over by Lalit Narayan Mithila University, **classes commenced on 19th October 2024**.

D.El.Ed. Admissions (2024-26)

For the first time in the history of our institution, the D.El.Ed. program achieved **full enrollment with all 50 seats filled** for the 2024-26 batch. This milestone reflects growing recognition of our institution's quality. **Classes started on 25th November 2024**.

D.El.Ed. Results

The results for the D.El.Ed. first-year (2023-25 batch) and second-year (2022-24 batch) students were announced this term, **meeting our expectations**.

Social-Emotional Learning: Introducing a new Value-Added Course

A standout development this term has been the redesign of the Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) program by our Secretary and **international trainer, Ratna Choudhry**. What was once a two-day workshop is now a **30-hour value-added course** integrated into the B.Ed. curriculum. This initiative will soon be rolled out for the D.El.Ed. cohort.

Pre-Internship & Internship Training

B.Ed. (2023-25)

The B.Ed. 2nd year students received **45 hours of pre-internship training** between 23rd Sep and 14th Oct 2024 that included lesson planning, creating and utilizing teaching-learning materials (TLMs), and **intensive teaching practice** in a safe, simulated environment. Their **16-week internship commenced on 15th Oct**, in four middle and high schools, providing them their first experience of hands-on teaching experience.

D.El.Ed. (2023-25)

Between 2nd Sep to 31st Oct, 2024, the D.El.Ed. 2nd year students received **90 hours of pre-internship training** that included Pratham's TaRL workshop, action research & learning plan preparation and practice. Their **14-week internship began on 12th Nov** in four primary and middle schools. A highlight of this internship has been their involvement in Pratham's Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) initiative for grades 3-5.

B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. (2024-26)

Our first-year students are gearing up for their **one-month internship, set to commence on 3rd February**. They are undergoing intensive training in micro-teaching skills, case studies, and action research to prepare for their first school experience. A total of 100 students will be placed across 10 local schools.
